1st Annual Region 7 AYSO Wild Wing Volunteer Recognition Tournament Team Invitation



Hello, Coaches!

AYSO Region 7 is proud to invite your team to the 1st Annual Region 7 AYSO Wild Wing Volunteer Recognition Tournament

Scope: AYSO Invitational – open to AYSO teams only from all Sections.

When: Friday, Saturday & Sunday, November 28 to November 30, 2008 – Rain Dates Jan 2. to Jan. 4, 2009

Where: The tournament will be held at Neilsen Field, Edward Vincent Jr. Park, Playa Vista Sports Park & St. Bernard High School Fields located in Westchester, CA., Inglewood, CA, Playa Vista, CA & Playa del Rey, CA. There is no charge for parking. No pets are allowed at fields.

Who: AYSO boys and girls teams in age divisions: U-14 (11v11) 15 players max. U-12 (9v9) 14 players' max. and U-10 (7v7) 10 players max. All players must be registered to play in the AYSO 2008 primary season. Guest players will not be allowed. No Co-ed teams will be accepted.

What: Pool play tournament. Each team will be guaranteed 3 games in pool play. The top teams will advance to the medal round on Sunday afternoon. All games will be as follows: 50 min. for U-14, 50 min for U-12, and 40 min for U-10.

Why: The Wild Wing Tournament is being conducted as a fundraiser by Region 7 to raise funds for Field Development, Equipment, & Maintenance, and to provide Scholarship funds for disadvantaged youths in Region 7.

Awards: All players and 2 coaches per team will receive a tournament t-shirt and pin. All players on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th place teams will receive a trophy or medal. Referees completing 3 games or more will receive a meal voucher, t-shirt and toss coin.

Sportsmanship Awards: Medals will be awarded to one team in divisions U10-U14 that compiles the largest amount of sportsmanship points. Referees will score the teams based upon conduct of players, coaches, spectators, uniform appearance and courtesy to referees and opposing team players.

Entry Fee, Refunds: \$ 395 U-14, \$395 for U-12, and \$345 for U-10. A full refund will be issued if tournament is canceled and cannot be rescheduled. If a team withdraws 30 or more days before the tournament, a full refund is given. Within 30 days of the tournament, no refund is provided unless a replacement team is found.

Referee Fee, Refunds: \$ 225 refundable within 14 days of the tournament, if referee assignments have been completed. Each team is asked to provide a qualified 3-person referee team to cover 3 games during the tournament. Partial refunds will be given based upon the number of game slots completed. Where possible Regions will be assigned a block of games as to minimize travel and time spent at the tournament. Refunds will be returned to respective Regional Commissioner.

Rules: A full set of tournament rules are posted on the tournament website.

Acceptance: The application deadline is October 15th.. All teams will be notified within 48 hrs. of the application deadline or receipt of application (whichever is latest) as to their status. Teams that are not accepted will be given the option to have their complete application returned or to be placed on the waiting list.

Waiting List: Applications not received by the deadline will be placed on the waiting list. Once a division is full, additional applications will be notified for instructions for disposition.

Failure to Submit Initial Team Roster: A team that has timely submitted an application but fails to timely submit its initial team roster will be moved to the waiting list and will be replaced. ROSTERS ARE CRITICAL AND MUST BE SUBMITTED ON TIME to ensure participation.

Team Rosters deadline will be November 3rd. Volunteer Verification deadline will be November 3, 2008.

Teams not accepted will be notified within 48 hours of the application deadline and their check will be returned as soon as possible.

- How: Team entry applications and all necessary forms are available on the tournament website. Please send 1, one, Region check that covers both the Entry and Referee fees, along with the tournament application, referee information form, and team roster to the Tournament Registrar address below. Regional commissioner must sign application and team roster. Appropriate referee administrator must sign referee information form. See referee form for details.

- Verification Teams will be required to show proof of parents volunteer status, for example, a regional directory, Board of Directors listing, signed by Regional Commissioner, etc. The information can be mailed to the Registrar prior to team check in.
- Medical Emergencies Paramedic dispatch will be available for all venues. Hospitals are within 5-10 minutes of each venue. Each venue will have a First Aid station. AYSO Injury forms and Each Field Director is trained and will have a walkie talkie to communicate to Emergency personnel.
